SAFE ONLINE SHOPPING THIS HOLIDAY SEASON

- Use strong, unique passwords for each account you create, and don't reuse the same password for different accounts.
- Never use public Wi-Fi to make purchases or log in to sensitive accounts. Instead, use a secure home Wi-Fi network or your mobile data plan.
- Shop only at trustworthy and reputable online retailers. Look for the "HTTPS" in the web address, indicating a secure connection.
- 4. Avoid clicking on links in unsolicited emails or texts they may be phishing attempts.
- Use a mobile payment app like Apple Pay, Google Wallet, or PayPal instead of entering credit card information directly on retailer websites.
- Keep your device software updated with the latest security patches and anti-virus software.
- Set up two-factor authentication on your accounts to add an extra layer of security.

- Check your bank and credit card statements regularly for any fraudulent charges.
